The Houston Grand Opera Association announces chorus auditions for its 2019-20 season. Auditions will be held at the Wortham Theater Center on:

Wednesday	May 1, 2019	6-10pm
Thursday	May 2, 2019	6-10pm
Saturday	May 4, 2019	10am-5pm

The Houston Grand Opera Chorus is a professional group of diverse persons of all professions and backgrounds. Choristers rehearse weekday evenings and weekends for each repertory period. In the 2019-20 season, a new chorister could earn approximately \$3,000.00 per production.

The 2019-20 season productions in which the chorus will participate are:

***Rigoletto* – Giuseppe Verdi**
***Saul* – Georg Friedrich Händel**
***La Favorite* – Gaetano Donizetti**
***Aida* – Giuseppe Verdi**
***Die Zauberflöte* – Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart**

Auditions should include two arias of contrasting style, tempo, in original language, and by memory. Operatic repertoire is preferred, but standard oratorio selections will be accepted. Sight reading may be requested. Singers are required to bring their own music in the correct key. HGO will provide an accompanist.
