General Information

The Houston Grand Opera Orchestra is a core group of 49 musicians and is the sole orchestra for the Houston Grand Opera. The 2021-22 Principal Flute per service rate is \$360.83 with 72 guaranteed services; approximately \$25,979.76 in guaranteed wages. Core members may participate in the HGO health insurance plan with a percentage paid by the Association. A 11.99% contribution is made to the AFM Pension Fund in the 2021-22 season.

The winner of this audition would be engaged to begin playing with the orchestra on November 29, 2021, or January 4, 2022, depending on availability.
